



Competition Rules & Regulations

Article 1: Organizer of the competition

CODATU (Cooperation for Urban Mobility in the Developing World) is organizing a photo competition, free and open to all, on the topic: *“Change mobility, not climate”*. This competition is launched in the context of the upcoming COP21 conference in which sustainable mobility will have a key role to play.

Article 2: General conditions

2.1 Duration of the competition

The competition will be open till 1st November 2015, midnight (French time).

2.2 Participation

The competition is open to all adults and amateur photographers. All participants will have to register on CODATU’s website by filling the form and accepting the rules and regulations. The sole participation to the competition implies acceptance of all the present rules.

Article 3: Photo characteristics

3.1 The photo has to clearly respond to the theme: *“Change mobility, not climate”*

3.2 Each participant can submit up to two photos along with its title. The photo(s) will be uploaded directly online, at the time of the registration on CODATU’s website: codatu.org.

3.3 The name of the file(s) has to follow this format: `surname_name-Title.jpg`

3.4 Images must be submitted in a JPEG or TIFF format only, with a minimum resolution of 30x40cm at 300 dpi (3543 x 4724 pixels), and a maximum size of 20Mo.

3.5 Photos which sexually offend or are provocative in nature will be rejected.

Article 4: Vote and Judging

4.1 50% of the results will come from the online vote on social networks (Facebook and Twitter), the remaining 50% will come from the decision of a judging panel composed of an urban transport communication expert (Ms. Dominique Fèvre, UTP), a journalist (Mr. Olivier Razemon, Le Monde) and an international transport expert (Mr. Michael Kodransky, ITDP).

4.2 The vote will be organized online and open to all from 2nd to 12th November 2015 on CODATU’s website.

Article 5: Notification of winners, exhibition and prizes

5.1 The results will be disclosed on CODATU’s website on the 16th of November 2015. The winner will be personally informed by mail and by phone.

5.2 The winning photo will be displayed on CODATU's home page for one month.

5.3 CODATU will also propose to French cities to expose the best photos of the competition in their public transport networks during COP21.

5.3 Three prizes will be awarded to the best photos:

1st prize: 600€ + free registration to CODATU XVII conference in New Delhi in 2017

2nd prize: 300€

3rd prize: 150€

Article 6: Copyright

The entrant warrants that the image submitted is the original work of the Photographer and that the Photographer holds copyright and must retain all rights as required by CODATU. The participant also transfers to the organizers, on a non-exclusive and non-commercial basis, the rights of utilisation of its photo, for an undefined term, on all media. CODATU commits to using the photos only for communication purposes and of mentioning the name of the author each time the photo is being used.

Article 7: Privacy of information

Personal and demographic information provided will not be used for the purpose other than those related to CODATU operated programs. Your information will be handled with respect and will not be sold, given away, or provided to parties without your consent, unless the law requires that it be shared.

Pursuant to the Law on Privacy of Personal Information of 6th January 1978, amended by the law of 6th August 2004, the user is entitled to access, obtain, correct and, as applicable, disallow the distribution of their personal data. The user may at any time disallow forwarding of his or her information to third parties. Article 8: Responsibility of the organizer
